## Translation of local grades into ECTS grades

Achievements of Erasmus students are to be graded according to the state examination grading scale.

The law faculties in Germany have developed their own unique (state examination) grading scale, different from that of other faculties. Marks run from 0 to 18 points, a pass being 4 points upwards.
