**Lecture about**  
**Corporate Governance in Transitional Countries**

As a part of the Erasmus Teaching Staff Mobility Prof. Danila Djokic from Slovenia will in her lectures "Corporate Governance in Transitional Countries" focus on the presentation of the case of the Republic of Slovenia.

She is going to enlighten the process of the companies transformation in the last 25 years and the changes that happened in the country in this period of time. The initiation of the process, started with the mass privatisation of the equity capital and the corporatisation of the companies is something very unique and different from the German experience. The historical background will be used to show the recent development of the legal system and legal sources that frame the organisation of the companies and determine the corporate governance in Slovenia and other transitional countries. The reasons and grounds for the recent status of the corporate governance will be explained and the problems evaluated. She will also explain the method of measuring the corporate governance quality in the public companies of some transitional countries and some results of the empirical research on this field.
